

Momentum Jury

The task of the Momentum Jury of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences is to evaluate and rank the applications on the basis of the criteria published in the call for applications and the reviews made by external experts, and by its ranking proposal contributes to the decision made by the Momentum Committee. Furthermore the Momentum Jury evaluates the progress reports of the funded Momentum research groups. The Momentum Jury carries out its scientific evaluation work in the scientific Panels divided into the three major disciplines (humanities and social sciences, life sciences, mathematics and natural sciences). The Momentum Jury consists of the Chair of the Momentum Jury, the Chairs of the three Panels (humanities and social sciences, life sciences, mathematics and natural sciences) and the members of the Panels. The Chair of the Momentum Jury as well as the Chairs and members of the Panels are invited by the Secretary-General of MTA, and their mandate is for three years, which may be extended for a further three years. With regard to the invitation of the Chair and the members of the Momentum Jury, the importance of ensuring the proportional representation of the scientific fields through the invitation of prestigious experts should be kept in mind.
